WebHunt to navigate our science class website

This WebHunt is to be completed by Monday 10 February

This year students will learn to balance the use of Web 2.0 tools with traditional learning, inquiry and investigation. This class website allows all students to access their learning, even though they may be absent from class. Parents are able to keep track of the type and quantity of work that their children are to complete. Each Webpage holds tasks for students to complete.

Here follows a WebHunt to help students and Parents/Caregivers navigate our class website.

- 1. Glue this sheet to your Interactive Science Notebook (ISN) right-side page (page 2) and write any notes, suggestions or diagrams on the left-side page (page 1). Tick the checklist as you complete each point.
- 2. Find <u>http://mrsmorrittscience.weebly.com/index.html</u> and bookmark the page.
- Navigate across the top Menu Bar to find the tab <u>Home</u> page and click on it. Scroll to News Feed.
 - a. Check that you have written the homework in your College diary.
 - b. Complete the homework by the due date.
 - c. What other features can you find on the Home page?
- 4. Navigate across the top Menu Bar to find the tab <u>Interactive Science Notebooks</u> and click on it. Scroll past the videos (watch them again if you like) to the **Instructions for the embedded sheet "Guidelines for the Interactive Science Notebook"**.
 - a. Complete the instructions in full.
 - b. Make some notes about this page on the left-side page of your ISN.
- 5. Navigate across the top Menu Bar to find the *Laboratory Safety* tab and click on it.
 - a. Read the list of Safety Rules and view the Laboratory Safety Rap video.
 - b. Classify the rules into what you think are the six most important and present them on the left-side page of your ISN.
- 6. Navigate across the top Menu Bar to find the **<u>9AEP Chemistry Program</u>** and click on it.
 - a. Check that your hard copy of the Chemistry program is glued into your ISN. This should be on the inside front cover of your ISN.
- Navigate across the top Menu Bar to find the 9AEP Chemistry Program and hover there to allow the drop down menu tab <u>9AEP Elements Review Wk1</u> to appear and click on it.
 a. Navigate to this page and complete Task 2 Instructions for your ISN.
- 8. Navigate across the top Menu Bar to find the <u>Blog</u> tab and click on it. Scroll down to **The New Periodic Table Song**. Watch the video and leave a comment. You may search through the **Archives** or **Categories** to leave a comment. Remember your **Netiquette** and that this is an educational website, so use appropriate language. Your comment comes to me for approval before it is posted.
